(1) Education promotion scholarships (good academic performance) will be given to new students, both Thai and international ones who come to enroll in various programs of the institution, including the Thai language program, the English program and the international program.

1) Recipients of Category 1 education promotion scholarships (full scholarships).

In the case of doctoral degree, the recipient must have at least GPA 3.50 at the master's degree level.

(2) International relations promotion scholarships.

International relations promotion scholarships include Category 1 education promotion scholarships (full scholarships), These scholarships will be given to new students who are foreigners having a relationship or engaging in a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the institution. In this regard, the qualifications of scholarship recipients shall be as prescribed by the Educational Institution Administration Sub-Committee.

2. Details of the education promotion scholarships.

(1) Education promotion scholarship recipients (good academic performance) and Category 1 international relations promotion scholarships (full scholarships).

1) All tuition fees will be waived throughout the program. The special activity fee waiver shall be at the discretion of each program's administrator.

2) The recipients will receive financial support for personal expenses: 30,000.- baht per semester and 15,000.- baht per summer semester.

(1) Education promotion scholarships (good academic performance).

1) In case of following a program plan and working on a thesis, the conditions are as follows:

(a) The recipients of Category 1 education promotion scholarships (full scholarships) must obtain a cumulative grade point average for each semester of not less than 3.50 to be eligible for semester personal allowance. If the cumulative grade point average is below 3.50, they are not eligible for personal expenses support. However, if the cumulative grade point average is not lower than 3.30, all tuition fees will be waived. If they receive a cumulative grade point average of less than 3.30 in any semester, they will not be eligible for the scholarship.

2) In the case of working on a thesis plan, the conditions are as follows:

(a) The recipients of Category 1 education promotion scholarships (full scholarships) must report the progress of their thesis every semester. The thesis advisor must certify their thesis to ensure their eligibility to receive funding for personal expenses in each semester. And their thesis must meet the program requirements and regulations of the National Institute of Development Administration on graduate studies. If scholarship recipients do not report their progress, their thesis will no longer meet the requirements for the scholarship.

(2) International relations promotion scholarships.

1) In case of following a program plan and working on a thesis, the conditions are as follows:

(a) Recipients of Category 1 international relations promotion scholarships (full scholarships) must obtain a cumulative grade point average for each semester of not less than 3.30 to be eligible for funding for personal expenses in each semester. If the cumulative grade point average is below 3.30, they are not eligible for personal expenses support. However, if the cumulative grade point average is not less than 3.00, they will receive a scholarship fee waiver. If they receive a cumulative grade point average of less than 3.00 in any semester, they will not be eligible for the scholarship.

2) In the case of working on a thesis plan, the conditions are as follows:

(a) Recipients of international relations promotion scholarships Category 1 (full scholarships) must have a progress report on their thesis every semester certified by their thesis advisor to be eligible to receive funding for personal expenses in each semester. And the thesis must meet the program requirements and regulations of the National Institute of Development Administration on graduate studies. If scholarship recipients do not report on their progress, their thesis will no longer be qualified for the scholarship.

(3) Scholarship recipients will no longer be eligible for the scholarship if they are later found requesting to resign or ceasing to be students. In case they are unable to graduate as specified in the regulations of the National Institute of Development Administration on graduate studies, all scholarship funds received must be returned to the institution unless otherwise considered by the Educational Institution Administration Subcommittee.

(4) If the scholarship recipient resigns or ceases to be a student and is unable to graduate as specified in the regulations of the National Institute of Development Administration on graduate studies or requests cancellation of the scholarship, all funds received must be returned to the institution unless otherwise considered by the Educational Institution Administration Subcommittee.

(5) In the event that the scholarship recipient has to re-register for a particular course, he or she will not be exempted from the tuition fees in the re-enrolled course.

Scholarship's terms and conditions

1. Qualifications of scholarship recipients.

(1) Education promotion scholarships (good academic performance) will be given to new students, both Thai and international ones who come to enroll in various programs of the institution, including the Thai language program, the English program and the international program.

1) Recipients of Category 1 education promotion scholarships (full scholarships).

In the case of doctoral degree, the recipient must have at least GPA 3.50 at the master's degree level.

(2) International relations promotion scholarships.

International relations promotion scholarships include Category 1 education promotion scholarships (full scholarships), These scholarships will be given to new students who are foreigners having a relationship or engaging in a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the institution. In this regard, the qualifications of scholarship recipients shall be as prescribed by the Educational Institution Administration Sub-Committee.

2. Details of the education promotion scholarships.

(1) Education promotion scholarship recipients (good academic performance) and Category 1 international relations promotion scholarships (full scholarships).

1) All tuition fees will be waived throughout the program. The special activity fee waiver shall be at the discretion of each program's administrator.

2) The recipients will receive financial support for personal expenses: 30,000.- baht per semester and 15,000.- baht per summer semester.

3. Rules for scholarship acquisition, scholarship suspension and scholarship reimbursement.

(1) Education promotion scholarships (good academic performance).

1) In case of following a program plan and working on a thesis, the conditions are as follows:

(a) The recipients of Category 1 education promotion scholarships (full scholarships) must obtain a cumulative grade point average for each semester of not less than 3.50 to be eligible for semester personal allowance. If the cumulative grade point average is below 3.50, they are not eligible for personal expenses support. However, if the cumulative grade point average is not lower than 3.30, all tuition fees will be waived. If they receive a cumulative grade point average of less than 3.30 in any semester, they will not be eligible for the scholarship.

2) In the case of working on a thesis plan, the conditions are as follows:

(a) The recipients of Category 1 education promotion scholarships (full scholarships) must report the progress of their thesis every semester. The thesis advisor must certify their thesis to ensure their eligibility to receive funding for personal expenses in each semester. And their thesis must meet the program requirements and regulations of the National Institute of Development Administration on graduate studies. If scholarship recipients do not report their progress, their thesis will no longer meet the requirements for the scholarship.

(2) International relations promotion scholarships.

1) In case of following a program plan and working on a thesis, the conditions are as follows:

(a) Recipients of Category 1 international relations promotion scholarships (full scholarships) must obtain a cumulative grade point average for each semester of not less than 3.30 to be eligible for funding for personal expenses in each semester. If the cumulative grade point average is below 3.30, they are not eligible for personal expenses support. However, if the cumulative grade point average is not less than 3.00, they will receive a scholarship fee waiver. If they receive a cumulative grade point average of less than 3.00 in any semester, they will not be eligible for the scholarship.

2) In the case of working on a thesis plan, the conditions are as follows:

(a) Recipients of international relations promotion scholarships Category 1 (full scholarships) must have a progress report on their thesis every semester certified by their thesis advisor to be eligible to receive funding for personal expenses in each semester. And the thesis must meet the program requirements and regulations of the National Institute of Development Administration on graduate studies. If scholarship recipients do not report on their progress, their thesis will no longer be qualified for the scholarship.

(3) Scholarship recipients will no longer be eligible for the scholarship if they are later found requesting to resign or ceasing to be students. In case they are unable to graduate as specified in the regulations of the National Institute of Development Administration on graduate studies, all scholarship funds received must be returned to the institution unless otherwise considered by the Educational Institution Administration Subcommittee.

(4) If the scholarship recipient resigns or ceases to be a student and is unable to graduate as specified in the regulations of the National Institute of Development Administration on graduate studies or requests cancellation of the scholarship, all funds received must be returned to the institution unless otherwise considered by the Educational Institution Administration Subcommittee.

(5) In the event that the scholarship recipient has to re-register for a particular course, he or she will not be exempted from the tuition fees in the re-enrolled course.

(6) In the case that the scholarship recipient is enrolled in a course other than what is specified in the program of study, he or she will be exempted from the registration fee for that course only when he or she receives advice from the academic advisor to enroll in that course.

(7) The scholarship recipient must work for the faculty or the institute for at least 6 hours per week.

(8) The recipient of this scholarship does not have the right to apply for any other grant of the institution except for thesis publication from the National Budget.

(9) Category 1 education promotion scholarship (good academic performance) and international relations promotion scholarship (full scholarships) recipients will be waived tuition fees according to the program structure plan. However, they must register according to the program structure plan. Exemption from so doing according to the program structure plan must be approved by the Dean of the Faculty of Admission.

4. Conditions for recipients of Category 1 education promotion scholarships (good academic performance) and international relations promotion scholarships (full scholarships).

(1) Scholarship recipients will be funded for personal expenses each semester only when they are enrolled in Semesters 1 and 2 for not less than 9 credits per semester or register in accordance with the program study plan. The summer semester requires enrollment of at least 3 credits for both Master's and Doctoral level students in order for them to be eligible for support.

(2) Scholarship recipients will be exempted from the application fee for the first comprehensive examination only.

(3) Scholarship recipients will pay for the status maintenance fee if their enrollment exceeds the scholarship period.

(4) The scholarship recipients shall pay the fees for thesis format examination/E-THESIS information system service.

(5) The doctoral thesis work must be published or has been accepted for publication in an international journal that has been attended by outside directors (Peer Review) prior to publication. In this regard, international journals must comply with the criteria set forth by the Office of the Civil Service Commission in Higher Education Institutions (OCSC) or the Royal Golden Jubilee Ph.D. Program (RGJPHD), excluding Proceedings.

5. Funding Period (counting from the opening day of the semester that the recipient is registered as a student).

- Doctoral degree programs - recipients will receive a scholarship for a period of 3 academic years.
